Discussion:

- **Note** the significance of King David, while subordinate to Abraham or Moses, becomes the identity of the Jews and their future hope – a King who will reign forever!
- **Discuss** the conditional nature of God's covenant with Solomon, and why this is irrelevant to the unconditional nature of God's covenant with David
- **Note** that both David and Solomon authored Psalms, as well as others writers, and that many of the Psalms are prophetic.
- **Discuss** the qualification of some prophecies which may seem obscure or of dubious applicability are qualified in NT passages which quote them in context of their fulfillment.
- **Note** the fulfillment of OT prophecy in the life of Christ is often cited by Jesus to his disciples during his lifetime (especially in Matthew) and is subsequently referenced in later NT passages.
