Romans 6:14, 17-18	Sin enslaves, salvation frees
Romans 6:23	Wages and gift
Romans 7:6, 8:1, 28	No condemnation for us in Christ
Romans 10:10-13	Calling on the name of the Lord
Romans 11:25-29	God not through with Israel
