### **Lesson Text:**

<b>Romans 6:1-3</b>	Ref. 5:20-21, We have died to sin
<b>Romans 6:3-7</b>	Being dead to sin
<b>Romans 6:8-11</b>	Alive to Christ
<b>Romans 6:12-18</b>	Warfare of two masters
<b>Romans 6:19-23</b>	Transitioning from Sin-master to Righteousness-master

### **Discussion:**

- **Discuss** the implications of being “dead to sin.”
- **Jump ahead** and consider Romans 12:1-2 in regard to being dead to sin.
- **Note** that the established victory for Christians does not infer that sinful influence has ended – the struggle is never-ending throughout our lifetime.
- **Discuss** Romans 6:14 in terms of the fact that we do not struggle against sin on our own, but in the power of God’s hands.

### **Open Questions:**

1. What degree of commitment is Paul asking for?
2. Does this passage of scripture apply to the modern church?
3. To what degree should Christians allow this passage to influence their plans for life and their daily activities?
