## Notes:

- 1. Conservative estimates generally range from 4,000 BC to no earlier than 10,000 BC. 4004 BC is used by Ussher (1654) for the creation of man and is held by Scofield, Unger, Wilkinson & Boa, and seems the most popular among conservative evangelicals. The traditional Jewish date is 3760 BC.
- 2. Date is somewhere between Creation and Abraham, number is based generally on counting generations
- 3. Date is somewhere between Abraham and Moses, being set among peoples who were descendants of Ishmael and traditionally written (or edited, or obtained) by Moses sourcing his father-in-law, a priest who lived in the same area that Job had lived. Presumed to take place during Egyptian captivity.
