

Old Testament Sacrifice and Worship Mt Sinai Catches Fire

- **God Covenants with a Nation**
- Exodus 19:1-9
 - v 1 – 3 Months, Exodus 12:41
 - v 3, 7 – “house”, “sons”, “elders” – family context
 - v 5, 6, 8 – Initial offer and acceptance
 - v9 – People to believe in Moses forever – Revere the Word of God
- Exodus 19:10-17 – Sanctification of people and mountain
- Exodus 19:18-24 – v22, 27 (v6) – Priests exist already – 430 years in Egypt
- **The 10 Commandments – Matthew 22:37-40**

Love God

- Exodus 20:1-6
 - v2 – I AM Jehovah your God
 - v3 – 1. No other gods
 - v4 – 2. No graven images – air, land, or sea
 - Literal idolatry – Romans 1:23
 - Equivalent idolatry – Colossians 3:5, 1 Corinthians 10:7
- Exodus 20:7-11
 - v7 – 3. Not to use the name of Jehovah inappropriately
 - v8-11 – 4. Honor God by observing the Sabbath
 - Unique to God and Israel (31:16-17)
 - Jesus raised on Sunday, Apostolic churches met on Sundays

Love one another

- Exodus 20:12-18
 - v12 – 5. Honor father and mother
“That your days may be long in the land” also tagged to other commands – indication of parents teaching children obedience to the Law
 - v13 – 6. Murder – not just “kill”
 - v14 – 7. Adultery
 - v15 – 8. Steal
 - v16 – 9. False witness – Judicial implications
 - v17 – 10. Covet – 1 Timothy 6:10 (Love of money)
