- **Tabernacle built by Moses**

- **Original temple built by Solomon**

- **Rebuilt temple built by Zerubbabel**
- **Herod's Temple – a massive expansion** (Herod the Great)

- **Ezekiel's Temple** (prophesied Ezekiel 40+)
- **Church Age Believer**
- **The New Temple – Millennial Kingdom**

Solomon

1. David forbidden to build, as a man of war – II Samuel 7, I Chronicles 23
2. Glory of Solomon – I Kings 4:20-26
3. Expresses intent with King Hiram (Phoenician King, ally of David, then Solomon)
I Kings 5:1-5
4. I Kings 5:13-18 183,300 Conscripts – probably men of Solomon's army
5. I Kings 6 Physical attributes
 - a. 6:11-14 Conditional Blessing of God
6. I Kings 7 More
 - a. 7:48-51 Inner Sanctuary
7. I Kings 8:1-11 Ark and Shekinah Glory
8. I Kings 8:12-61 Benediction, Prayer, Dedication
9. I Kings 8:63 (62-66) Sacrifices – Thanksgiving of 22,000 sheep, 120,000 sheep
10. I Kings 9:1-9 Conditional Blessing of God
